Keeping Ourselves Safe

Over the next few weeks we will be teaching the personal safety programme Keeping Ourselves Safe. Keeping Ourselves Safe has been designed to give students the skills to cope in situations where they might (or should) feel uncomfortable. It has three overall aims:

- ... to develop and strengthen children's skills to keep themselves safe with other people, both online and face-to-face
- ... to support and encourage children to get help from caring adults
- ... and to empower these adults with the necessary skills and knowledge

Keeping Ourselves Safe will be taught by your child's teacher, with support from the local Police School Community Officer.

To be successful, Keeping Ourselves Safe needs your help and support. Your child may have home activities to work on with you. It is important that you participate as much as possible please and

talk to your child about what they have been learning. This will reinforce the messages the school is giving.

Any questions along the way, please contact your child's teacher, or we can connect you with the police education team.
