For this event, parents need to transport their children to and from the grounds and also look after them as there won't be a school member attending on the day.

Judging commencing at 10.00 am. Please note <u>Calves must</u> be preregistered and entry forms received prior to the day. An updated programme will be given out on the day.

A few things as a reminder:

- All animals must be born after 1st July 2024.
- Each competitor can only enter one of the three sections: calf, lamb, or goat.
- All participants should wear enclosed footwear when showing their animals and a school t-shirt
- All children entering a calf, lamb, or goat will receive a Certificate of Participation and Ribbon.
- Pre-schoolers are not allowed to attend.
- All entrants will go into the "Whangarei A & P Society Lucky Draw" which will draw at Prize-giving.
- The correct ring sizes are:
- Calves 15 x 15 Lambs 10 x 10 Goats 10 x 10

The day will only be postponed under extreme conditions, so the likelihood of this happening is very slim. An announcement will be made on all radio stations if the day will be postponed by 7am. The postponement date is Friday 8^{th} of November 2024.

Pipiwai Road Pavement Rehabilitation

From 29 October to mid-December there will be restrictions on road usage on Pipiwai Road from the Dip Road roundabout to number 131 Pipiwai Road (towards Parikiore).

These restrictions will apply from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm each week day. The road will be open at night and on weekends.
